Idea for thought Pack items in Large container: Pack ALL camper items in (1) large container, such as a large duffel, Rubbermaid tub, large suitcase, or footlocker/trunk.

<u>Label everything:</u> Everything must be marked with the camper's name, especially towels, shirts, cameras, etc. Campers tend to lose unmarked items. Please label everything!

<u>Tell someone of your plans</u> - give details of where you are going and when you expect to return, give directions and possible alternative roads that you may take, provide cell phone numbers, vehicle description and license plate numbers, hand-held radio channel and codes that you will use, and provide local authority phone numbers (State Police, Game & Fish Commission, Sheriff Dept, etc.) for the county or area that you will be in.

Additional First Aid Tips

- Take a First Aid class and a CPR class keep current on this information
- Keep supplies in a well marked, durable, waterproof container
- Keep the contents organized
